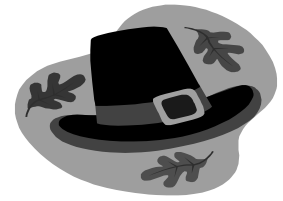


# November Volunteer Opportunities
